Yard Waste Reminder

Contractor shall not be required to collect more than three cubic yards (20 bags) per collection of Yard Trash.

Brush included therewith shall not exceed four (4) inches in diameter or more than three (3) feet in length.

Yard Trash shall be placed in sturdy paper bags suitable for containing Yard Trash or in other suitable containers, excluding the carts and plastic bags; or if greater than four (4) inches in diameter and not placed in a suitable container.

Yard Trash shall be tied in a bundle weighing not more than fifty (50) pounds.

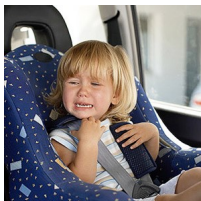


No Child Left Inside!

Now that the dog days of summer have arrived, it is time for an important **HEAT ADVISORY!** Never leave your child or dog alone in a hot car. Not even for a quick run into the store.

According to Safe Kids Worldwide, 10 is the number of minutes it takes the inside of a car to heat up 20 degrees (and cracking the window doesn't help). On average, every 10 days a child dies from heatstroke in a vehicle.

Avoid heatstroke related injury or death by never leaving your child alone in a car, **not even for one minute.** Make sure the car is locked when you're not in it so kids don't go in on their own. If you see a child alone in a car, call 911. Emergency personnel want you to call.



Ditch & Right-Of-Way Alterations

Town ditches and watercourses serve important functions including draining roads of water, draining surrounding land, carrying water to a proper outfall and providing a location for snow storage below the road surface.

Landowners are responsible for general maintenance of these areas such as mowing, removal of weeds, brush and other obstruction.

Any improvements or alterations to ditches by landowners must be approved by the Town.

Changes or alterations to ditches made without Town approval ***may*** be required to be removed. This may include retaining walls, landscaping, concrete mailboxes, drainage or other improvements.

Household Hazardous Waste

Residents are encouraged to dispose of their hazardous materials during the hazardous waste collection days held at Outagamie County Recycling & Solid Waste, located at 1919 Holland Road, Appleton.

The program will run May - October from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on the following days:

- **Wednesdays: July 21; August 18; September 15; October 20**
- **Saturdays: July 24; August 21; September 18; October 23**

Types of hazardous wastes include—Automotive supplies such as: gasoline, fluids for motors; engine oil; anti-freeze; lead acid batteries. Cleaners such as: drain & oven cleaners; pool chemicals; household cleaners & aerosols. Garden & Lawn care supplies like: herbicides; insecticides; weed killer & poisons. Miscellaneous household items include: oil & lead paints; varnish & stains; spray paints & adhesives; paint thinners; wood preservatives; kerosene and mercury.

If you are unable to attend one of the scheduled collection dates and times, Outagamie County residents may utilize the Brown County Hazardous Waste Facility located at 2561 S. Broadway Dr., Ashwaubenon, WI for free. Thursdays 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. & Saturdays 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., find more information at:

2022 Garbage, Recycling & Yard Waste Info

Bulky Item & Appliance Pick-Up

Bulky items must have stickers on them. All stickers need to be purchased at the Town Hall office before noon on the Tuesday before pick-up each month. Pick-up for these items is scheduled **on the third Wednesday of each month.**

Large bulky items and appliances will cost \$20.00 each. Small bulky items will cost \$10.00 each.

We can not take items that contain Freon or any TVs

Holiday Week Pick-Ups

When your garbage day falls within the week of a holiday, **everyone who normally has their pick-up on that holiday, and everyone after the holiday during that week, will be delayed one day for pick-up.**

When is Garbage & Recycling pick-up?

Recycling is picked up every other week on the same collection day as your garbage. To find out the collection day for your specific street, go to the Town's website under Town Services.

2022 Yard Waste Collection Weeks

During these weeks only, yard waste goes out on your normal garbage day. Please use a biodegradable bag or canister that can be dumped.

- Always keep water close by

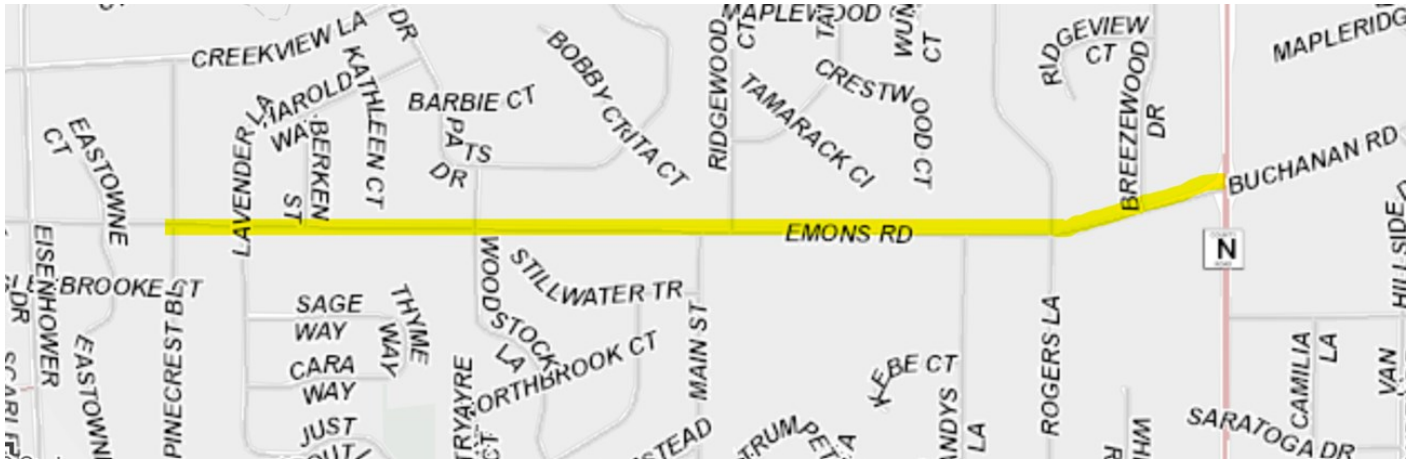


Annual Road Construction

2022 Roadway Projects (A22): Creekview Lane (Speel School Rd to Eisenhower Dr),



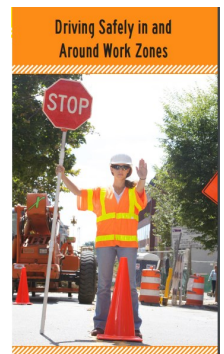
Westowne Ct (includes section of Emons Rd to Eisenhower)
