NO CHILD LEFT INSIDE!!

Now that the dog days of summer have arrived, it is time for an important **HEAT ADVISORY**! Never leave your child or dog alone in a hot car. Not even for a quick run into the store.

According to Safe Kids Worldwide, 10 is the number of minutes it takes the inside of a car to heat up 20 degrees (and cracking the window doesn't help). On average, every 10 days a child dies from heatstroke in a vehicle.

Avoid heatstroke related injury or death by never leaving your child alone in a car, <u>not even for one minute</u>. Make sure the car is locked when you're not in it so kids don't go in on their own. If you see a child alone in a car, call 911. Emergency personnel want you to call.

Ditch & Right-Of-Way Alterations

Town ditches and watercourses serve important functions including draining roads of water, draining surrounding land, carrying water to a proper outfall and providing a location for snow storage below the road surface.

Landowners are responsible for general maintenance of these areas such as mowing, removal of weeds, brush and other obstruction.

Any improvements or alterations to ditches by landowners must be approved by the Town.

Changes or alterations to ditches made without Town approval *may* be required to be removed. This may include retaining walls, landscaping, concrete mailboxes, drainage or other improvements.

Permit/Sticker

Use of the site is limited to Town of Buchanan residents who are part of the Town Garbage collection program. Fee for the Permit/Stickers will be an annual fee of \$40.00 for 2 stickers per household, which is non-refundable and can be picked up at the Town Hall.

There will no longer be curbside pickup service and a sticker will need to be purchased to dispose of yard waste at the Yard Waste Transfer Site.



Household Hazardous Waste

Residents are encouraged to dispose of their hazardous materials during the hazardous waste collection days held at Outagamie County Recycling & Solid Waste, located at 1919 Holland Road, Appleton.

The program will run May - October from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on the following days:

Wednesdays: July 12; August 9; September 13; October 4 Saturdays: July 15; August 12; September 16; October 7

Appointments are required!!! Online: www.RecycleMoreOutagamie.org or call (920) 832-5277.

Types of hazardous wastes include—Automotive supplies such as: gasoline, fluids for motors; engine oil; anti-freeze; lead acid batteries. Cleaners such as: drain & oven cleaners; pool chemicals; household cleaners & aerosols. Garden & Lawn care supplies like: herbicides; insecticides; weed killer & poisons. Miscellaneous household items include: oil & lead paints; varnish & stains; spray paints & adhesives; paint thinners; wood preservatives; kerosene and mercury.

If you are unable to attend one of the scheduled collection dates and times, Outagamie County residents may utilize the Brown County Hazardous Waste Facility located at 2561 S. Broadway Dr., Ashwaubenon, WI for free. Thursdays 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. & Saturdays 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 pm., find more information at:

2023 Garbage, Recycling & Yard Waste Info

Bulky Item & Appliance Pick-Up

Bulky items must have stickers on them. All stickers need to be purchased at the Town Hall office before noon on the Tuesday before pick-up each month. Pick-up for these items is scheduled on the third Wednesday of each month.

Large bulky items and appliances will cost \$20.00 each. Small bulky items will cost \$10.00 each.

We can not take items that contain Freon or any TVs.

Holiday Week Pick-Ups

When your garbage day falls within the week of a holiday, everyone who normally has their pick-up on that holiday, and everyone after the holiday during that week, will be delayed one day for pick-up.

When is Garbage & Recycling pick-up?

Recycling is picked up every other week on the same collection day as your garbage. To find out the collection day for your specific street, go to the Town's website under Town Services.

ATV/UTV

Permitted Roads:

All town roads are open to ATV/UTV usage,

County Roads (CE/N/KK/Z/ZZ/GG) ARE NOT open to ATV/UTV's.

The exception to Town roads is where we butt up against other municipalities.

On Emons Road, Westbound from Main St to Pinecrest Blvd is not permitted, however Eastbound riding is because it's within the Town.

Which means a person cannot run the entire length of Emons Road from County Road N to Eisenhower Dr heading Westbound, however they can legally run Eastbound without issue.

The Westbound traffic would have to detour down Main St and come around on Springfield Dr.

Prohibited Roads:

Emons Westbound from Main St to Pinecrest Blvd

Pinecrest Blvd Northbound from Emons Rd to Creekview Ln

Creekview Ln Eastbound from Pinecrest Blvd to just after Don's Dr.

Block Rd from DeBruin Rd Westbound to W2221 Block Rd

FIRE SIGNS

To all rural residents of the Town of Buchanan on the entire eastern side of the township. The Fire Department will be starting the installation of the posts and signs in the near future. The signs will be placed in the yards on the backside of the ditches with a metal post. Any addresses that were added after the signs were ordered will be addressed in the near future. They measure 8 inches tall by 20 inches long and blue with white reflective lettering and include the Town of Buchanan on the top with the address number in the middle and the road name on the bottom, these are single-sided signs.
