With the return to school, the increase of children on and near the roadways can cause increased danger for pedestrians and drivers. Please observe the following safety rules and tips on how to drive near school buses:

- Be aware of the peak school commuting hours in your town and pay extra attention while driving.
- Drive carefully and at reduced speeds in neighborhoods where children congregate at bus stops and especially in school zones.
- Slow down when driving behind a school bus as they may make frequent and sudden stops.

Learn the flashing light signal system used in your state. This generally consists of slowing down when the bus is flashing yellow lights and coming to a complete stop while the bus is flashing red lights.

#### Yard Waste Transfer Site Update

#### Eligible Users

Town residents residing in households serviced by the Town Garbage collection program are eligible to use the Site. This does not include Commercial, Rental Property Owners, and Businesses. To use the Site residents must acquire a Yard Waste Transfer Site Sticker from the Town Hall, after filling out the application and paying the sticker price of \$40.00.

The stickers are valid for one (1) calendar year. You may have (2) two stickers per household.

#### SNOW SEASON REMINDERS Winter Parking Regulations

Per the Code of the Town of Buchanan, (§495-14 and §495-19), no person shall park any vehicle upon any street in the Town between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1st through March 31st.

#### Snow & Ice on Sidewalks

Residents and business owners are reminded that sidewalks adjacent to their property need to be cleared and maintained clear of snow and ice throughout the winter season. Please note that shoveling, blowing or plowing snow into the street is against the law and endangers the motoring public.

#### **Snow Emergencies**

There may be occasions when the Town must declare a snow emergency. The decision to declare a snow emergency is made on a case-by-case basis and is determined on conditions and available resources. When a snow emergency is declared there shall be no parking upon any street in the Town for 48 hours or until snow removal operations have been completed. The Town will make an announcement of such emergency to be broadcast on WHBY and WAPL radio stations, Facebook, Twitter, and the Town website.

#### Storage of Boats, Campers & Trailers

From November 1 to March 31st of each year, boats, campers and trailers may no longer be stored within the front yard. These items may be stored year round in the side yard on a gravel/paved surface or in the rear yard. Certain setback restrictions apply. Please visit our website for more information.

#### Abandoned & Junked Vehicles

Pursuant to §492-2 of the Code of the Town of Buchanan, no person owning or having custody of any

abandoned or junked motor vehicle shall store or permit any such vehicle to remain on any private property for a period of more than ten (10) days. Such storage is declared to be a public nuisance and may be abated or removed and forfeiture may be imposed.

## **Bulky Item & Appliance Pick-Up**

Bulky items must have stickers on them. All stickers need to be purchased at the Town Hall office before noon on the Tuesday before pick-up each month. Pick-up for these items is scheduled on the third Wednesday of each month.

Large bulky items and appliances will cost \$20.00 each. Small bulky items will cost \$10.00 each.

## **Holiday Week Pick-Ups**

#### **CALLING ALL DOGS!**

#### 2024 tags will be available around December 1, 2023.

If you are more than five months old, tell your owner that you need a shiny new tag for your collar.

Your owner must bring in a current rabies vaccination certificate from a veterinarian in order to be issued a license. It's only \$7.00 if you are spayed or neutered, but your owner needs to bring proof of that from your veterinarian.

Dog licenses are sold at the Town Hall or by downloading and mailing the completed application with payment, rabies certificate & self-addressed stamped envelope.

The annual license fees are as follows:

Spayed or Neutered - \$7.00

Not Spayed or Not Neutered - \$12.00

Limit - 3 Dogs

Licenses issued after March 31, 2024 will be an additional \$5.00.

2023 Tax Bills will be mailed in mid-December.

IN FULL OR 1ST INSTALLMENT: Payable to the Town of Buchanan by January 31, 2024 Address: N178 County Rd. N, Appleton, WI 54915.

We encourage you to mail your payment, by check or money order and please include your phone number on the check!

*The Town of Buchanan discourages cash payments. Tax payments can be dropped in our drop box on the Southwest corner of Town Hall.*

SECOND INSTALLMENT:

The Town of Buchanan <u>cannot</u> accept second installment payments!

#### **RECEIPTS**

Receipts will be dated the date on which the monies are physically received at the Treasurer's office. If you require a receipt, <u>enclose a self-addressed</u>, <u>stamped envelope</u> along with your tax bill stub and payment.

All paid tax information is available on Outagamie County's website as soon as payments are posted, and you can print payment information for your records.

#### TAX OVER PAYMENT REFUNDS

No refund is given, unless payment is over the full tax bill amount. There are **NO CASH REFUNDS** for amounts over \$30.00. Refund checks will be issued within three weeks after payment is applied.

If you are a Town of Buchanan resident and would like a set of numbers for your property, you may stop in and request a set or email clerk@townofbuchanan.wi.gov. We will put it together and let you know when it is ready to be picked up. Remember, these numbers could be a lifesaver in case of an emergency so you want to make sure you have them visible.

#### 2024 Tentative Capital Improvement Projects

The following Capital Improvement Projects have been discussed for 2024.

The projects will be made official as part of the 2024 budgeting process which takes place during September-November of each year.

1. Construction of Traffic Lights and turn lanes at the intersection of CTH Rd KK and State Park Road. This project is in partnership with Calumet County and the Village of Harrison.

2. Reconstruction of Van Handle Drive.

3. Springfield Park Phase 2. This includes improvements to Springfield Park as identified in the Master Plan the Town approved at its July 18, 2023 meeting which include new playground equipment, basketball courts, tennis and pickleball courts and a walking trail.
