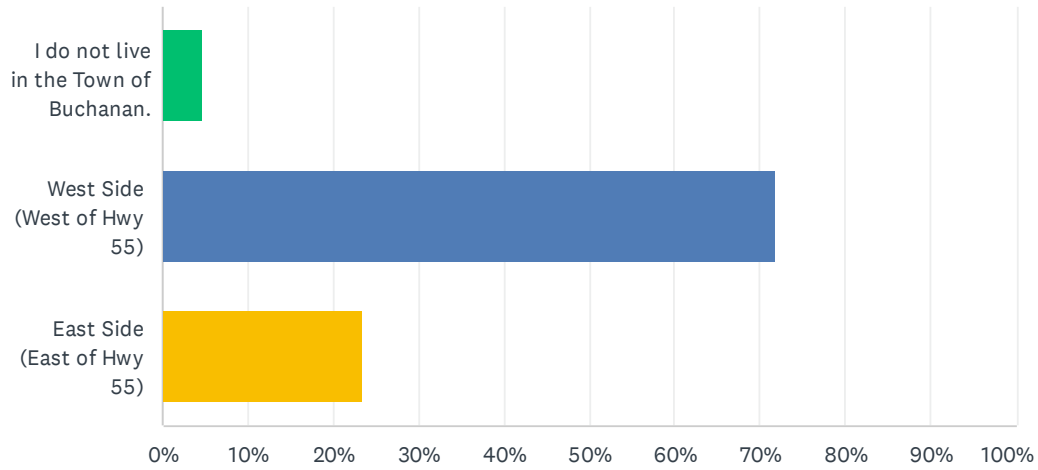


Q1 Where do you live in the Town of Buchanan?

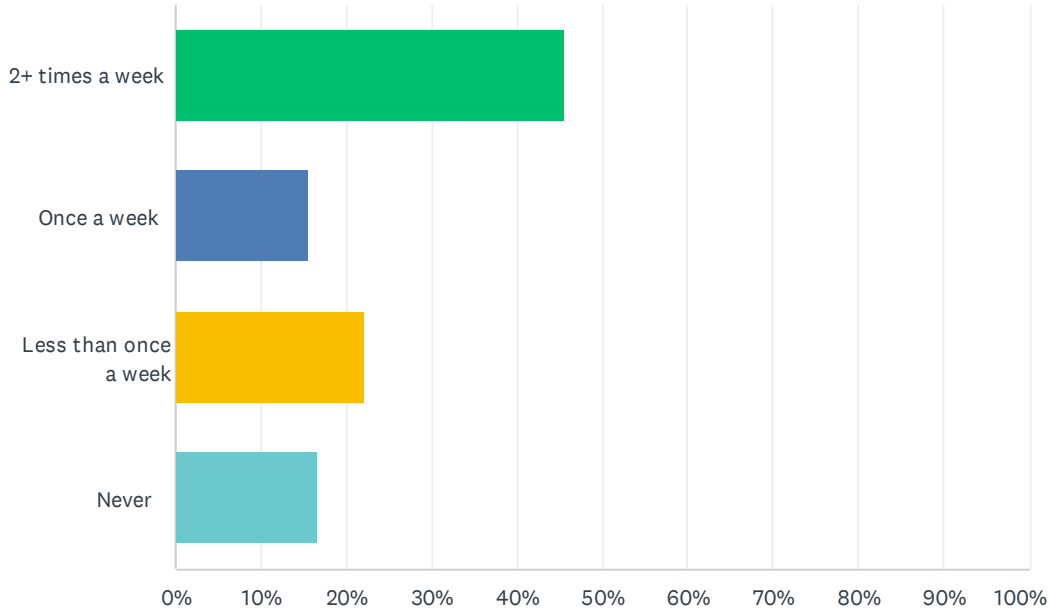

Q2 In the summer, how often do members of your household visit parks and/or utilize trails in the Town of Buchanan?

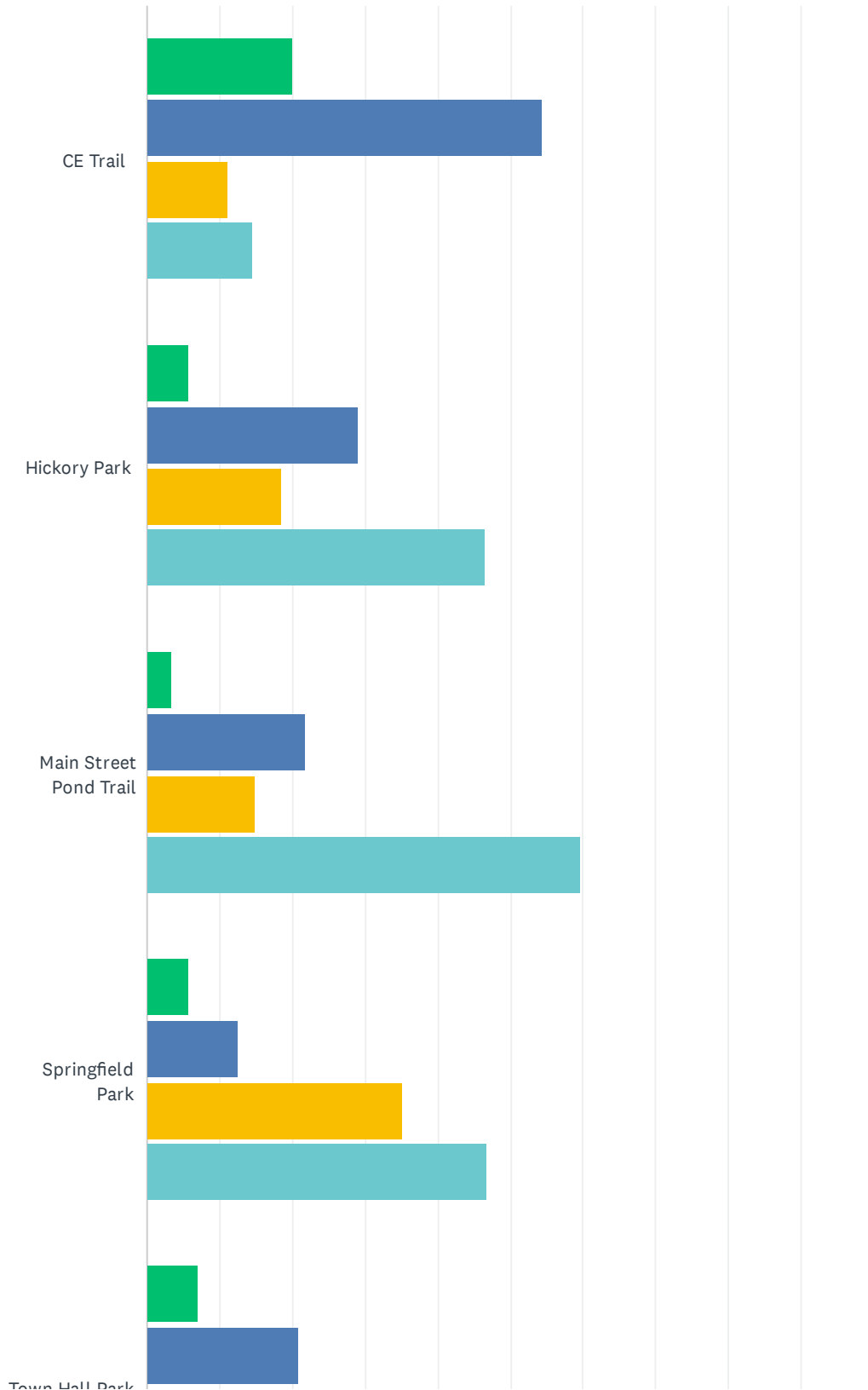

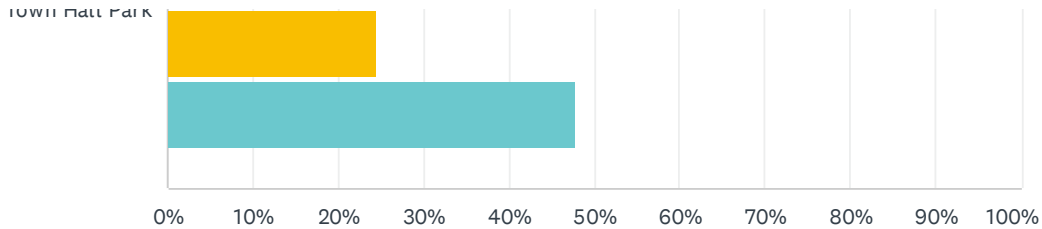

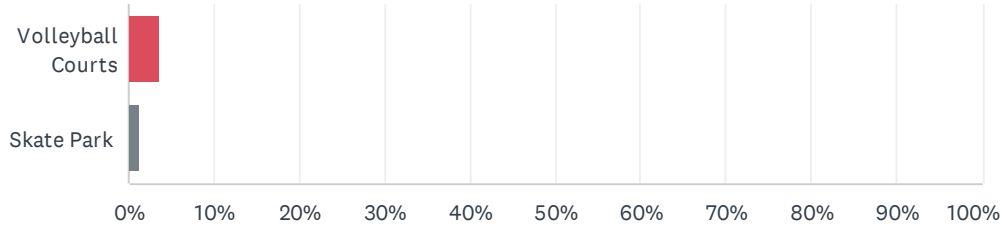

Q9 What is your gender?

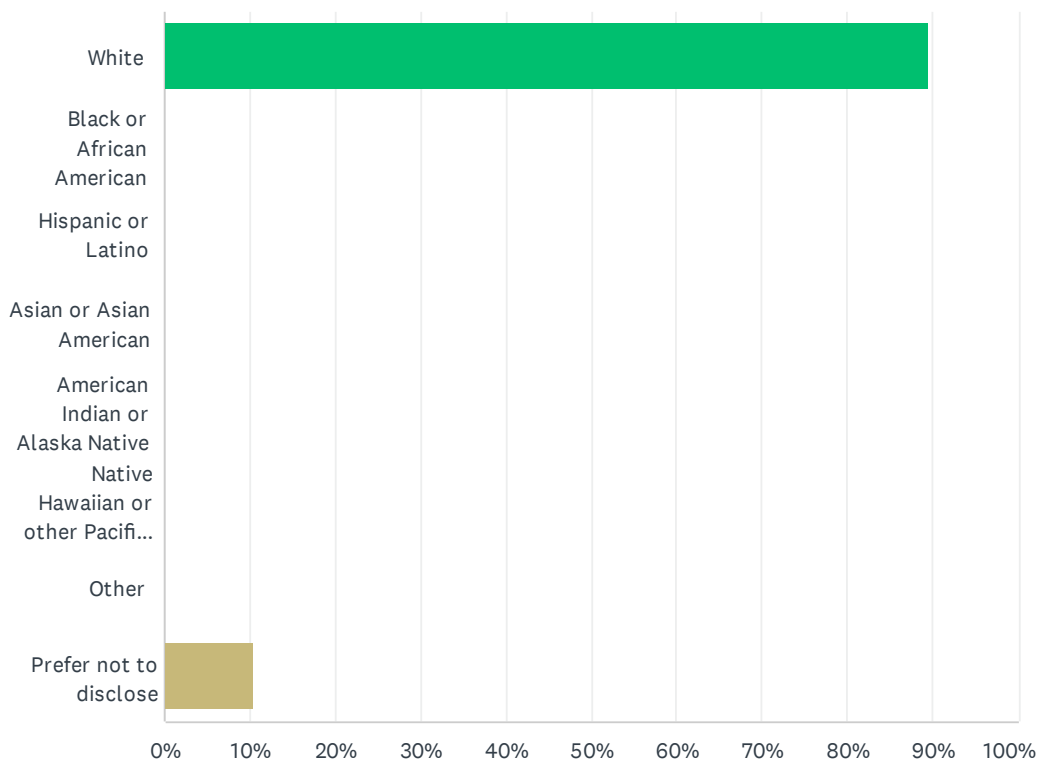
