Burning Permits

No person shall start or maintain any open burning without obtaining a burning permit issued by the Town of Buchanan. This does not include small recreational fires provided that the fire is confined by a control device or structure such as a fire ring or fire pit. There is no fee for the annual burn permit.

Open burning shall only be conducted on Saturdays, other than legal holidays, as defined by § 995.20, Wis. Stats., between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

No Child Left Inside!

Now that the dog days of summer have arrived, it is time for an important **HEAT ADVISORY!**Never leave your child or dog alone in a hot car. Not even for a quick run into the store.

According to Safe Kids Worldwide, 10 is the number of minutes it takes the inside of a car to heat up 20 degrees (and cracking the window doesn't help). On average, every 10 days a child dies from heatstroke in a vehicle.

Avoid heatstroke related injury or death by never leaving your child alone in a car, **not even for one minute**. Make sure the car is locked when you're not in it so kids don't go in on their own. If you see a child alone in a car, call 911. Emergency personnel want you to call.



If you are more than five months old, tell your owner that you need a shiny new tag for your collar.

Your owner must bring in a current rabies vaccination certificate from a veterinarian in

order to be issued a license. It's only \$7.00 if you are spayed or neutered, but your owner needs to bring proof of that from your veterinarian.

Dog licenses are sold at the Town Hall or by downloading and mailing the completed application with payment, rabies certificate & self-addressed stamped envelope.

The annual license fees are as follows:

Spayed or Neutered - \$7.00 Not Spayed or Not Neutered - \$12.00 Limit—3 dogs

<u>Licenses issued after March 31, 2024 will be an</u> additional \$5.00

FIRE SIGNS

To all rural residents of the Town of Buchanan. The Fire Department will be continuing the installation of the posts and signs in the near future.

The signs will be placed in the yards on the backside of the ditches with a metal post. Please do not remove or move them.

They measure 8 inches tall by 20 inches long and blue with white reflective lettering and include the Town of Buchanan on the top with the address number in the middle and the road name on the bottom, these are single -sided signs.

Household Hazardous Waste

Residents are encouraged to dispose of their hazardous materials during the hazardous waste collection days held at Outagamie County Recycling & Solid Waste, located at 1919 Holland Road, Appleton.

Cleaners such as: drain & oven cleaners; pool chemicals; household cleaners & aerosols. Garden & Lawn care supplies like: herbicides; insecticides; weed killer & poisons. Miscellaneous household items include: oil & lead paints; varnish & stains; spray paints & adhesives; paint thinners; wood preservatives; kerosene and mercury.

Spring Ditch Cleaning

Any property owner in the Town of Buchanan who has property which abuts any ditch, watercourse, or other earthen structure, as described above, shall be responsible to control activities upon and maintain the owned property in such a manner as to not cause or contribute to obstructions in the ditch, watercourse or other earthen structure which would restrict, block or prohibit the free, open and continuous flow of water through the ditch, watercourse, or other earthen structure. Per code 504-43a.

ANNUAL ROAD CONSTRUCTION

ATV/UTV

Permitted Roads:

All town roads are open to ATV/UTV usage,

County Roads (CE/N/KK/Z/ZZ/GG) ARE NOT open to ATV/ UTV's.

The exception to Town roads is where we butt up against other municipalities. On Emons Road, Westbound from Main St to Pinecrest Blvd is not permitted, however Eastbound riding is because it's within the Town. Which means a person cannot run the entire length of Emons Road from County Road N to Eisenhower Dr heading Westbound, however they can legally run Eastbound without issue. The Westbound traffic would have to detour down Main St and come around on Springfield Dr.

Prohibited Roads:

Emons Westbound from Main St to Pinecrest Blvd Pinecrest Blvd Northbound from Emons Rd to Creekview Ln Creekview Ln Eastbound from Pinecrest Blvd to just after Don's Dr.

Block Rd from DeBruin Rd Westbound to W2221 Block Rd ALL County Roads CE/N/KK/Z/ZZ/GG

You must follow all Department of Natural Resources (DNR) regula-Children under 18 must wear a DOT regulated helmet (NOT A BICYCLE HELMET)
