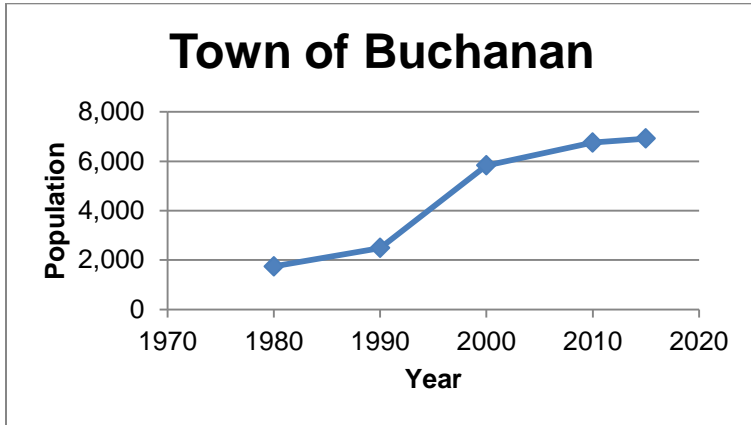

Historic Population Trends

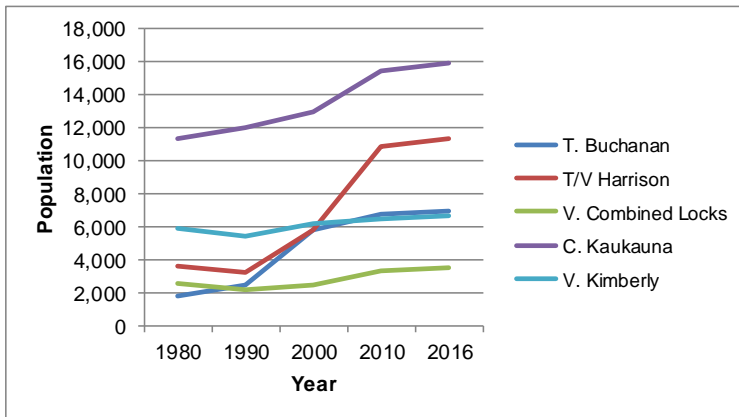

Historic Population Trends

- Population of Town grew by over 134% between 1990 and 2000, far outpacing surrounding communities & Outagamie County
- Between 2000 and 2010, the population growth rate in the Town slowed significantly to about 16%. While the growth rate in the T Harrison, V Combined Locks, C. Kaukauna and Outagamie County increased.
- WDOA estimates that between 2000 and 2016, growth rates in the surrounding communities and Outagamie County decreased.

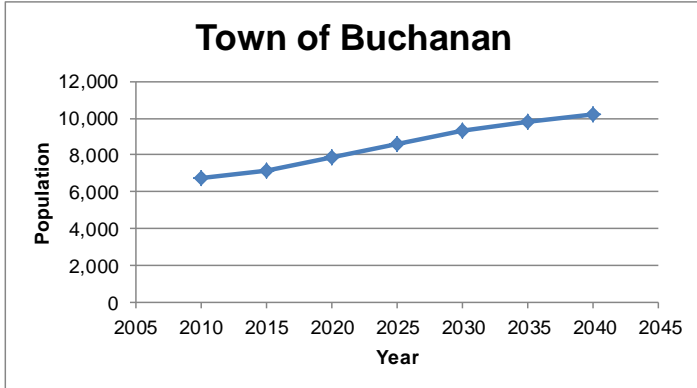

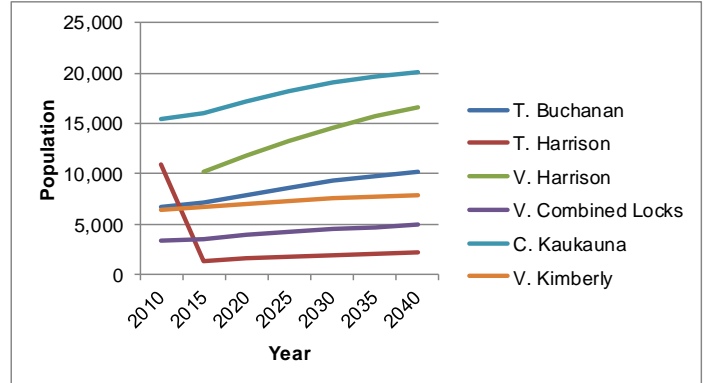

Future Population Projections

- Between 2010 and 2040, the population in the Town of Buchanan is expected to grow by about 51%.
- Combined the T/V Harrison is expected to grow by 73% over this same time period.
- According to the 2016 population estimate, growth in the Town is slightly behind the 2015 projection projection.

Future Household Projections

- Between 2010 and 2040, it is estimated that 1,572 households will be added in the Town (65.3%).
- In comparison the number of households in Outagamie County is expected to grow by 32.9% and in Wisconsin by 22.4%.
- The household size is larger in the Town of Buchanan than in the county and state and is expected to continue to be larger.
- As the number households increase, the persons per household are expected to decrease.
