2022 Town Budget Overview

The Town Board approved the 2022 Town budget of \$7,773,649 at their regular meeting on Tuesday, November 16, 2021. This will result in a Town tax rate of \$3.09 per \$1,000 of assessed value. This is a decrease of 5¢ per \$1,000 of assessed value from the prior year. Please note the Town tax only accounts for approximately 22% of your gross property tax bill.

- \$7,773,649 in total expenditures
- \$3,396,154 in general operating expenditures, a 1.4% increase from 2021
- \$2,490,680 Town tax levy, a 4.9% increase from 2021
- \$1,800,000 in debt proceeds for capital projects
- Tax rate of \$3.09/\$1000 of assessed value, a 1.7% decrease from the prior year tax
- Special charge for residential waste collection/disposal of \$153.19, an increase of 1.5% from 2021

What is the Town **Budget?**

Per the requirements under Wisconsin State Statutes, the Town of Buchanan is required to prepare and adopt an annual fiscal year budget. As required, the budget lists all existing indebtedness and all anticipated revenue from sources during the ensuing fiscal year.

Additionally, in appropriations for each department, service or activity must also be shown.

Property Tax Bills & Payments

IN FULL OR 1ST INSTALLMENT: Payable to the Town of Buchanan by January 31, 2022.

TAX OVER PAYMENT REFUNDS: No refund is given, unless payment is over the full tax bill amount. There are NO CASH REFUNDS for amount

Address: N178 County Rd. N, Appleton, WI 54915. We encourage you to mail your payment, by check or money order and please include your phone number on the check! The Town of Buchanan discourages cash payments. Tax payments can be dropped in our drop box on the Southwest corner of Town Hall. For details on how to pay property taxes by Credit or Debit card, go to Outagamie County's website: www.outagamie.org (Department-Treasurer).

The <u>Town of Buchanan does not accept credit or debit cards at</u> <u>Town Hall</u> at this time for tax payments.

SECOND INSTALLMENT: Payable to Outagamie County Treasurer by July 31, 2022 Address: 320 S. Walnut St., Appleton, WI 54911. The Town of Buchanan cannot accept second installment payments.

Receipts will be dated the date on which the monies are physically received at the Treasurer's office. If you require a receipt, enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope along with your tax bill stub and payment. All paid tax information is available on Outagamie County's website as soon as payments are posted, and you can print payment information for your records.

TAX OVER PAYMENT REFUNDS: No refund is given, unless payment is over the full tax bill amount. There are NO CASH REFUNDS for amounts over \$30.00. Refund checks will be issued within three weeks after payment is applied.

SPECIAL ASSESSMENT CODES: The following special assessment codes might appear on your tax bill: 03 Street Improvements; 03B Transportation Utility.; 04 Street Lights; 10P POWTS; 13 Garbage/Refuse Collection; 14 Extra Garbage bins; 14S Storm Water Utility. Tax balances can be viewed on the Outagamie County website.

Notice to Dog Owners:

Dogs running at large and untagged dogs are subject to impoundment; penalties.

Wisconsin State Statute 174.05 requires the owner of any dog more than five (5) months of age must have their dog licensed and tagged.

Dogs running at large and untagged dogs are subject to impoundment and the owners may pay penalties. A dog is considered to be running at large if it is off the premises of its owner and not under the control of the owner or some other person. A dog is considered to be untagged if a valid license tag is not attached to a collar which is kept on the dog whenever the dog is outdoors, unless the dog is securely confined in a fenced area. An officer shall attempt to capture and restrain any dog running at large or any untagged dog. If the owner of a dog negligently or otherwise permits the dog to run at large or be untagged, the owner shall forfeit not less that \$25 or more than \$100 for the first offense, and not less than \$50 or more than \$200 for subsequent offenses.

Holiday Week Pick-Ups

Bulky Item & Appliance Pick-Up

For bulky items and appliances to be picked-up, stickers need to be purchased at the Town Hall.

Bulky items must have stickers on them. All stickers need to be purchased at the Town Hall office before noon on the Tuesday before pick-up each month. Pick-up for these items is scheduled on the third Wednesday of each month. Large bulky items and appliances will cost \$20.00 each. Small bulky items will cost \$10.00 each.

Snow Emergencies!

There may be occasions when the Town must declare a snow emergency.

The decision to declare a snow emergency is made on a case-by-case basis and is determined on conditions and available resources.

If a snow emergency is declared, there shall be no parking on Town roads for 48 hours or until snow operations have been completed.

The Town will make announcements on broadcasts such as WHBY and WAPL radio stations, Twitter & the Town website.



Winter Parking Regulations

Per the Code of the Town of Buchanan, (§495-19 and §495-14), no person shall park any vehicle upon any street in the Town between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. from November 1st through March 31st.

Snow & Ice on Sidewalks

Residents and business owners are reminded that sidewalks adjacent to their property need to be cleared of snow and ice throughout the winter season. Please note that shoveling, blowing, or plowing snow into the street is against the law and endangers the motoring public.

Salting NEW Driveways

Residents are reminded that on new driveways you will NOT want to salt or to salt lightly

Fire Hydrants & Snow

Snow fall combined with frozen plowed snow, buries fire hydrants under large amounts of compacted snow, thus making them difficult to find and use in an emergency.

Don't let your neighborhood hydrant remain "undercover" this winter!

We ask that you help us by keeping the fire hydrant closest to your home or business clear of snow. Snow should be removed about three feet (3') away from the hydrant in all directions and a pathway cleared between the hydrant and the nearest roadway.

Storage of Boats, Campers & Trailers

From November 1st to March 31st of each year, boats, campers and trailers may no longer be stored within the front or side yard.

These items may be stored year round in the rear yard. Certain setback restrictions apply.

Abandoned & Junked Vehicles

Pursuant to §492-2 of the Code of the Town of Buchanan, no person owning or having custody of any abandoned or junked motor vehicle shall store or permit any such vehicle to remain on any private property for a period of more than ten (10) days. Such storage is declared to be a public nuisance and may be abated or removed and forfeiture may be imposed.

Permit Required

A permit shall be required for new installations and additions and alterations to any type of heating, ventilating and air-conditioning installation, and any type of ductwork. This shall include fireplaces, woodburning stoves, and similar equipment.



Open Burning:



- No person shall start or maintain any open burning without obtaining a burn permit issued by the Town of Buchanan. This does not include small recreational fires provided that the fire is confined by a control device or structure such as a fire ring or fire pit.
- 2. A fee for an annual burn permit has been eliminated.
- 3. Open burning shall only be conducted on Saturdays, other than legal holidays, as defined by § 995.20, Wis. Stats., between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
- 4. Permit can be obtained online.
