RESOLUTION NO. 2021-15**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN
CALUMET COUNTY AND THE TOWN OF BUCHANAN, OUTAGAMIE COUNTY
FOR TREATMENT OF STORMWATER RUNOFF FROM COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY
TO SPEEDWAY HEIGHTS POND**

WHEREAS, the Town of Buchanan ("Town") and Calumet County ("County"), collectively the "Parties", wish to enter into an intergovernmental agreement ("Agreement") pursuant to Wis. Stats. § 66.0301 for the purpose of treating stormwater runoff from County owned Right- of-Ways by the municipality in their Speedway Heights Pond;

WHEREAS, the County is required to remove pollutants from stormwater runoff of County owned Right-of-Ways in the urban area by WPDES Permit WI-S050075-3 and subsequent reissues of the permit;


WHEREAS, the Parties agree that stormwater runoff from approximately 1.71 Acres of County Road KK currently drain to the Speedway Heights Pond, owned by the Town (see Exhibit A), where pollutants are removed from the runoff; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to enter into this Agreement for the County to make monetary contributions to the Town pursuant to WPDES Permit WI-S050075-3, or any subsequent permits relating to the Speedway Heights Pond, for treating the stormwater running off of County Road KK.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Buchanan:


1. That the Intergovernmental Agreement is hereby approved in form and substance and the Administrator is hereby authorized to execute, and;
2. That the Intergovernmental Agreement shall not be effective until executed by both the County and the Town.
