Signs in Right-of-Way

The Town of Buchanan Municipal Code prohibits signs and markers in highways and Town right-of-way. Code: § 495-8 states, "that no person shall place within the limits of any street or highway maintained by the Town, any sign, signal, marker, mark or monument unless permission is first obtained from the Town."

Any item placed or maintained in violation of this code shall be subject to removal. Please be aware of this requirement with regard to signs for special events or sales, (including rummage sales & campaign signs), as they may be removed by the Town.

The Town may also charge violators for removal of items in right-of-way that are placed illegally.

CALLING ALL DOGS!

If you are more than five months old, tell your owner that you need a shiny new tag for your collar.

Your owner must bring in a current rabies vaccination certificate from a veterinarian in order to be issued a license. It's only \$7.00 if you are spayed or neutered, but your owner needs to bring proof of that from your veterinarian.

Dog licenses are sold at the Town Hall or by downloading and mailing the completed application with payment, rabies certificate & self-addressed stamped envelope. The annual license fees are as follows:

Spayed or Neutered - \$7.00 Not Spayed or Not Neutered - \$12.00 Limit—3 dogs

Licenses issued after March 31, 2022 will be an additional \$5.00

Ditch & Right-0f-Way Alterations

Town ditches and watercourses serve important functions including draining roads of water, draining surrounding land, carrying water to a proper outfall and providing a location for snow storage below the road surface.

Landowners are responsible for general maintenance of these areas such as mowing, removal of weeds, brush and other obstruction.

Any improvements or alterations to ditches by landowners must be approved by the Town.

Changes or alterations to ditches made without Town approval *may* be required to be removed. This may include retaining walls, landscaping, concrete mailboxes, drainage or other improvements. Code: § 504-44.

Household Hazardous Waste

Residents are encouraged to dispose of their hazardous materials during the hazardous waste collection days held at Outagamie County Recycling & Solid Waste, located at 1919 Holland Road, Appleton.

The program will run May - October from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on the following days:

• Wednesdays: May 12; June 23; July 21; August 18; September 15; October 20

• Saturdays: May 15; June 26; July 24; August 21; September 18; October 23

Types of hazardous wastes include—Automotive supplies such as: gasoline, fluids for motors; engine oil; anti-freeze; lead acid batteries. Cleaners such as: drain & oven cleaners; pool chemicals; household cleaners & aerosols. Garden & Lawn care supplies like: herbicides; insecticides; weed killer & poisons. Miscellaneous household items include: oil & lead paints; varnish & stains; spray paints & adhesives; paint thinners; wood preservatives; kerosene and mercury.

If you are unable to attend one of the scheduled collection dates and times, Outagamie County residents may utilize the Brown County Hazardous Waste Facility located at 2561 S. Broadway Dr., Ashwaubenon, WI for free. Thursdays 12:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. & Saturdays 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m., find more information at:

2022 Garbage, Recycling & Yard Waste Info

Bulky Item & Appliance Pick-Up

Bulky items must have stickers on them. All stickers need to be purchased at the Town Hall office before noon on the Tuesday before pick-up each month. Pick-up for these items is scheduled on the third Wednesday of each month.

Large bulky items and appliances will cost \$20.00 each. Small bulky items will cost \$10.00 each.

We can not take items that contain Freon or any TVs

Holiday Week Pick-Ups

When your garbage day falls within the week of a holiday, everyone who normally has their pick-up on that holiday, and everyone after the holiday during that week, will be delayed one day for pick-up.

When is Garbage & Recycling pick-up?

Recycling is picked up every other week on the same collection day as your garbage. To find out the collection day for your specific street, go to the Town's website under Town Services.

2022 Yard Waste Collection Weeks

During these weeks only, yard waste goes out on your normal garbage day. Please use a biodegradable bag or canister that can be dumped.




Emons Road (Pinecrest Blvd to CTH N)
