The Town Board of the Town of Buchanan, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, has adopted a resolution that certain public work or improvements be carried on in the Town, specifically to installation of public improvements including, but not limited to, street improvements, storm sewer, curb and gutter, and other required appurtenances; that a special assessment district be created consisting of all property fronting upon the following road:

- Creekview Lane (Speel School Road to Eisenhower Drive)
- Emons Road/Westowne Court (Eisenhower Drive to cul de sac)

That special assessments shall be levied against property in the district; and that the special assessments may be paid in full or the number of installments that shall be determined after the public hearing on the project; and Cedar Corp, the Town Engineer, has made and filed with the Town Clerk a report containing the plans and specifications of the project, an estimate of the entire cost of the project, and an estimate, as to each parcel affected, of the net amount of benefits. The amount assessed against each benefitted property within the assessment area will be made upon a reasonable basis not to exceed the total construction and material costs, including engineering fees, attorney's fees, publication expenses and other appropriate administrative expenses.

Notice is given that the report on file may be inspected at the office of the town clerk during normal business hours.

Notice is further given that the Town Board will hold a public hearing concerning the matters contained in the preliminary resolution and the report at 7:00 p.m. on June 21, 2022, at Town of Buchanan, N178 County Rd N, Appleton. All persons interested, or their agents or attorneys, may appear and be heard.
